This course will enable staff to explore the differences for many young female students who are on the autistic spectrum.

Course Aims:

- Identify how differences in social imagination and communication and interaction can be gender specific
- Consider concepts such as "masking", and comorbidities such as selective mutism, eating disorders and OCD often
 present
- Explore the prevalence of mental health difficulties for many of the students.

EYFS Cross-School Summer Term Moderation Thursday 20 June | 0930 – 1300 | Oldway Primary School, Paignton

This half day session, facilitated by the Torbay Early Years Team, provides an opportunity for cross school moderation of the EYFS Profile. It will support teachers in making accurate final judgements around children's emerging or expected attainment. There will be time for teachers to discuss any children they consider to be 'on the cusp' or areas of learning causing concern. Year 1 teachers are encouraged to attend in order to support effective transition into Key stage 1.

By the end of the session, you will be able to:

- Have confidence in your final judgments on children's attainment.
- Provide accurate information to Year 1 teachers.
- Have a shared understanding of emerging and what's expected in each area of learning.
